BACKGROUND - RATIONALE:

Board of Education:

During our claims audit procedures conducted during February 2016, we reviewed approximately 576 claims and have identified the items below that need to be reviewed. We have approved these claims for payment and release (except as noted below), as they were valid claims against the District. Although we noted the following instances during our review, the expenditures appear to be appropriate.

Findings:

1) There was 1 check (50689) that was held due to an incorrect check amount on February 25, 2016. The check was held because the vendor was overcharging the District by an amount of \$137.25 due to an incorrect hourly rate being charged for legal services. The claim was subsequently voided by the District and reissued for the correct amount on March 24, 2016.

Other Matters:

- 1) We noted 26 instances where the purchase order was dated subsequent to the date of the invoice or service date. While these confirming purchase orders provide evidence of expenditures, the real control is in ensuring that such purchases are approved by the Purchasing Agent before the goods or services are ordered by the department. Thus, to ensure that budgetary limits are monitored and expenditures are properly approved and obtained at the most appropriate price, all purchase orders, where practicable, should be generated prior to goods and services being ordered. We have discussed these issues with Management who is in the process of implementing solutions to address these issues.
- 2) We noted 5 instances where the purchase orders were increased after the invoice dates. We spoke to accounts payable to ensure that while the purchase orders were under-encumbered, there was enough money in the budget line for the expenditure. Even so, the increased amounts are essentially confirming, as the Purchasing Agent did not authorize these excess amounts.
- 3) We noted 1 instance where a payment was made to the incorrect budget year. The payment related to the 2013 2014 school year, but was being paid



from a purchase order from the 2015 – 2016 school year. The District should ensure that payments are being made to the correct budget year.

4) We noted 21 instances that contained invoices that were held for more than 90 days prior to payment. We recognize that invoices come from multiple departments within the District and understand that sometimes invoices are lost or misplaced or there may be problems with the products purchased that may require the District to hold payments. Management has advised the departments to remit approved invoices in a timely manner.

Check number 30670 was held on December 18, 2015 and released on February 3, 2016 when the evidence was provided by the District.

We understand the fiduciary duty of the Board of Education, as well as the role of the claims auditor in ensuring that all disbursements are valid and handled according to the provisions of the Education Law and the Board's policies and procedures.

During our claims audit procedures conducted during March 2016, we reviewed approximately 664 claims and have identified the items below that need to be reviewed. We have approved these claims for payment and release (except as noted below), as they were valid claims against the District. Although we noted the following instances during our review, the expenditures appear to be appropriate.

Findings:

1) There were 2 checks (50803 & 51009) that were held due to insufficient support. In the first instance, check 50803 was held as we needed proof of attendance for an event. This check was released on March 24, 2016 when the proof of attendance was received. In the second instance, check 51009 was held as we were unable to verify the transportation rate that Developmental Disabilities Institute was charging. Check 51009 was released on March 30, 2016 when the transportation rate was verified.

Other Matters:

- 1) We noted 27 instances where the purchase order was dated subsequent to the date of the invoice or service date. While these confirming purchase orders provide evidence of expenditures, the real control is in ensuring that such purchases are approved by the Purchasing Agent before the goods or services are ordered by the department. Thus, to ensure that budgetary limits are monitored and expenditures are properly approved and obtained at the most appropriate price, all purchase orders, where practicable, should be generated prior to goods and services being ordered. We have discussed these issues with Management who is in the process of implementing solutions to address these issues.
