TITLE: Establish Health & Welfare Services Rate for 2016-2017

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools be it resolved that the Board of Education establish the following rate for the provision of health and welfare services to out-of-district students attending non-public schools in the district for the 2016-17 school year:

\$1065.51 per pupil

BACKGROUND - RATIONALE:

According to section 912 of the Education Law, we must provide, when requested, health services, psychological services, social work services, and speech correction to out-of-district students attending non-public schools in the district. The cost of those services is then charged, pursuant to a state-approved formula, to the district of residence for such students. The rate for 2015-16 was \$1,023.93 per student.
