Upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools be it RESOLVED that the Board of Education, through the administration, arrange for the provision of the appropriate special education programs and services for students enumerated in the report of the Committee on Preschool Special Education.

On motion by Mr. Kornreich, seconded by Mrs. Gische, and carried by a 7-0-0 vote, the Board approved the resolution as presented.
