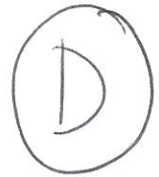

**TITLE: ESTABLISH HEALTH & WELFARE SERVICES RATE FOR 2018-2019**

**Staff Recommendation:**

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools be it resolved that the Board of Education establish the following rate for the provision of health and welfare services to out-of-district students attending non-public schools in the district for the 2018-19 school year:

\$1,260.28 per pupil

**Background-Rationale:**

According to section 912 of the Education Law, we must provide, when requested, health services, psychological services, social work services, and speech correction to out-of-district students attending non-public schools in the district. The cost of those services is then charged, pursuant to a state-approved formula, to the district of residence for such students. The rate for 2017-18 was \$1,189.80 per student.
