- (2) Replacement, Rehabilitation or Reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes..., and/or
- (9) Construction or expansion of a primary or accessory/appurtenant, nonresidential structure or facility involving less than 4,000 square feet of gross floor area...

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the THREE VILLAGE CSD (Board of Education) is considering improvements at the Paul J. Gelinas Jr. High School, located at 25 Mud Road, Setauket, New York 11733 and;

WHERAS, the proposed project includes

- District Wide door hardware replacement and security upgrades
- Asphalt pavement reconstruction, storm drainage and handicapped accessibility.

WHEREAS, pursuant to 6 NYCRR §617.5(a), "Actions or classes of actions identified in subdivision (c) of this section are not subject to review under this Part, except as otherwise provided in this section. These actions have been determined not to have a significant impact on the environment or are otherwise precluded from environmental review under Environmental Consideration Law, Article 8. The actions identified in subdivision (c) of this section apply to all agencies"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 6 NYCRR §§617.5(c) (1), (2) and (9), the "maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility", replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure of facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes...", and the "construction or expansion of a primary or accessory/appurtenant, nonresidential structure or facility involving less than 4,000 square feet of gross floor area..." are Type II actions.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education, after review of the proposed action, 6NYCRR §617.5, and the opinion provided by John A Grillo Architect PC, hereby determines that the proposed projects are Type II Actions pursuant to 6 NYCRR §§617.5(c) (1), (2) and (9) of the implementing regulations of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, and will, therefore, by definition, have no significant adverse impact on the environment.
