WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the THREE VILLAGE CSD (Board of Education) is considering improvements at the Ward Melville High School, located at 380 Old Town Road, Setauket, New York 11733 and;

WHERAS, the proposed project includes

- Complete renovations of two existing multi-tailed toilets to meet ADA needs of buildings handicapped population
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 6 NYCRR §617.5(a), "Actions or classes of actions identified in subdivision (c) of this section are not subject to review under this Part, except as otherwise provided in this section.
